- Restores provisions in the House-passed version of the bill that require the Ohio Military Veteran Educators Program (funded by an earmark of GRF ALI 200448, Educator Preparation) to do the following:
- 25 (1) Administer a grant program for higher education 26 institutions to provide financial incentive and assistance for 27 eligible military individuals to enroll in and complete an 28 educator preparation program (this provision was removed in the 29 Senate-passed version of the bill); and
- 30 (2) Subsidize the costs for eligible military individuals 31 associated with completing college coursework or professional 32 development in pedagogy for the purpose of obtaining 33 alternative military educator license (the Senate-passed version 34 of the bill replaced this provision with a requirement that the 35 program subsidize the costs for military individuals to complete 36 the required 15 hours of coursework for veterans employed as 37 unlicensed teachers).
