- "Sec. 3301.91. (A) As used in this section: 7
- (1) "National school breakfast program" means the federal 8
school breakfast program created under 42 U.S.C. 1773. 9
- (2) "National school lunch program" means the federal school 10
lunch program created under 42 U.S.C. 1751. 11
- (3) "Public school" means a school building operated by a 12
school district, a community school established under Chapter 13
3314. of the Revised Code, a STEM school established under Chapter 14
3326. of the Revised Code, a building operated by an educational 15
service center, a special education program operated by the county 16
board of developmental disabilities under section 3323.09 of the 17
Revised Code, or a facility offering juvenile day treatment 18

services.

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(B) The department of education and workforce shall reimburse each public and chartered nonpublic school that participates in the national school breakfast program, from funds appropriated by the general assembly for that purpose, an amount equal to the difference between the federal free reimbursement rate and the federal reimbursement for a reduced-price breakfast for each student eligible for a reduced-price breakfast and receiving breakfast.

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(C) The department shall reimburse each public school and chartered nonpublic school that participates in the national school lunch program, from funds appropriated by the general assembly for that purpose, an amount equal to the difference between the federal free reimbursement rate and the federal reimbursement for a reduced-price lunch for each student eligible for a reduced-price lunch and receiving lunch."

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"Sec. 3313.819. (A) As used in this section, "national school breakfast program," "national school lunch program," and "public school" all have the same meanings as in section 3301.91 of the Revised Code.

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(B) A public or chartered nonpublic school that participates in the national school breakfast program shall provide each student eligible for a reduced-price breakfast a breakfast at no cost to the student.

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A public or chartered nonpublic school that participates in the national school lunch program shall provide each student eligible for a reduced-price lunch a lunch at no cost to the student."

Free school breakfasts & meal reimbursements 61

R.C. 3301.91, 3313.819, 3314.03, and 3326.11 62

Restores a provision of the House-passed version of the bill 63
 that does the following: 64

Requires the Department of Education and Workforce (DEW) to 65
 provide reimbursements to make school breakfasts and lunches free 66
 for all students eligible for a reduced-price breakfast or lunch 67
 at public and chartered nonpublic schools that participate in the 68
 National School Breakfast or Lunch Program. 69

Requires public and chartered nonpublic schools that 70
 participate in the National School Breakfast or Lunch Program to 71
 provide each student eligible for a reduced-price breakfast or 72
 lunch at no cost to the student. 73

Qualifies special education programs operated by a county 74
 board of developmental disabilities and facilities offering 75
 juvenile day treatment services for reimbursements for 76
 reduced-price school meals. 77

Sections 265.10 and 265.200 79

Increases GRF ALI 200505, School Lunch Match (renamed by the 80
 amendment to School Meal Programs), by \$4,199,500 in each fiscal 81
 year and restores a provision in the House-passed version of the 82
 bill requiring this item to support the reimbursements described 83
 above, in addition to providing state matching funds for the 84
 school lunch program as under the Senate-passed version of the 85
 bill. 86
