"Sec. 6121.02. There is hereby created the Ohio water development authority. Such authority is a body both corporate and 5 politic in this state, and the carrying out of its purposes and 6 the exercise by it of the powers conferred by this chapter shall be held to be, and are hereby determined to be, essential 8 governmental functions and public purposes of the state, but the 9 authority is not immune from liability by reason thereof. The 10 authority is subject to all provisions of law generally applicable 11 to state agencies that do not conflict with this chapter. 12

The authority shall consist of eight members as follows: five

members appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of

the senate, no more than three of whom shall be members of the

same political party, and the directors of natural resources,

environmental protection, and development, who shall be members ex

officio without compensation. The director of development may

designate a person in the unclassified civil service to serve in

20 the director's place as a member of the authority notwithstanding 21 section 121.05 of the Revised Code. The appointive members shall 22 be residents of the state, and shall have been qualified electors 23 therein for a period of at least five years next preceding their 24 appointment. Appointed members' terms of office shall be for eight 25 years, commencing on the second day of July and ending on the 26 first day of July. Each member shall hold office from the date of 27 appointment until the end of the term for which the member was 28 appointed. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior 29 to the expiration of the term for which the member's predecessor 30 was appointed shall hold office for the remainder of such term. 31 Any appointed member shall continue in office subsequent to the 32 expiration date of the member's term until the member's successor 33 takes office, or until a period of sixty days has elapsed, 34 whichever occurs first. A member of the authority is eligible for 35 reappointment. Each appointed member of the authority, before 36 entering upon the performance of the duties of the office, shall 37 take an oath as provided by Section 7 of Article XV, Ohio 38 Constitution. The governor may at any time remove any member of 39 the authority for misfeasance, nonfeasance, or malfeasance in 40 office.

The authority shall elect one of its appointed members as 41 chairperson and another as vice-chairperson, and shall appoint a 42 secretary-treasurer who need not be a member of the authority. 43 Four members of the authority shall constitute a quorum, and the 44 affirmative vote of four members shall be necessary for any action 45 taken by vote of the authority. No vacancy in the membership of 46 the authority shall impair the rights of a quorum by such vote to 47 exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of the 48 authority. 49

Before the issuance of any water development revenue bonds

51 under this chapter, each appointed member of the authority shall 52 give a surety bond to the state in the penal sum of twenty-five 53 thousand dollars and the secretary-treasurer shall give such a 54 bond in the penal sum of fifty thousand dollars, each such surety 55 bond to be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the duties 56 of the office, to be executed by a surety company authorized to 57 transact business in this state, and to be approved by the 58 governor and filed in the office of the secretary of state. Each 59 appointed member of the authority shall receive an annual salary 60 of five seven thousand five hundred dollars, payable in monthly 61 installments, and is entitled to health care benefits comparable 62 to those generally available to state officers and employees under 63 section 124.82 of the Revised Code. If Section 20 of Article II, 64 Ohio Constitution, prohibits the Ohio water development authority 65 from paying all or a part of the cost of health care benefits on 66 behalf of a member of the authority for the remainder of an 67 existing term, the member may receive these benefits by paying 68 their total cost from the member's own financial resources, 69 including paying by means of deductions from the member's salary. 70 Each member shall be reimbursed for actual expenses necessarily 71 incurred in the performance of official duties. All expenses 72 incurred in carrying out this chapter shall be payable solely from 73 funds provided under this chapter, or appropriated for such 74 purpose by the general assembly and no liability or obligation 75 shall be incurred by the authority beyond the extent to which 76 moneys have been provided under this chapter or such 77 appropriations."
