11 **Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services**

12 **Sections 337.10 and 337.103**

13 Increases GRF ALI 336516, Appalachian Children Coalition,  
14 by \$1,250,000 in each fiscal year (from \$1,250,000 to \$2,500,000  
15 in each fiscal year), which restores the ALI to House-passed  
16 funding levels. Restores earmarks under the ALI to House-passed  
17 levels by increasing the earmark for:

- 18 • Training, hiring, and retention of entry-level child
- 19 mental health and behavioral health workers in school
- 20 and health provider settings by \$500,000 in each

21 fiscal year (from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 in each  
22 fiscal year);

23 • Research and facilitation of a publicly accessible  
24 database of child wellbeing indicators as well as to  
25 provide capacity to child-serving entities in the  
26 region by \$500,000 in each fiscal year (from \$500,000  
27 to \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year);

28 • Enhancing child mental health outcomes, promoting  
29 implementation of whole-child models of care, and  
30 expanding the mental health workforce in the region by  
31 \$125,000 in each fiscal year (from \$125,000 to  
32 \$250,000 in each fiscal year); and

33 • Prevention programming in the areas of teen suicide,  
34 substance misuse, human trafficking, bullying, and  
35 child abuse and neglect in the region by \$125,000 in  
36 each fiscal year (from \$125,000 to \$250,000 in each  
37 fiscal year).
