Requires the team that develops hospital security plans to	94
(1) include a patient of the hospital or a family member of a	95
patient and (2) be made up of at least 50% members who are	96
health care employees who provide direct patient care.	97
Permits the team that develops hospital security plans to	98
specify other data points to be included in a hospital's	99
security risk assessment.	100
Clarifies, for purposes of various provisions in the bill,	101
that law enforcement includes hospital police departments.	102
Removes a requirement that hospitals must submit to the	103
