"**Sec. 2151.271.** Except in a case in which the child is 4  
alleged to be a serious youthful offender under section 2152.13 5  
of the Revised Code, if the child resides in a county of the 6  
state and the proceeding is commenced in a juvenile court of 7  
another county, that court, on its own motion or a motion of a 8  
party, may transfer the proceeding to the county of the child's 9  
residence upon the filing of the complaint or after the 10  
adjudicatory, or dispositional hearing, for such further 11  
proceeding as required. The court of the child's residence shall 12  
then proceed as if the original complaint had been filed in that 13  
court. Transfer may also be made if the residence of the child 14  
changes. The proceeding shall be so transferred if other 15  
proceedings involving the child are pending in the juvenile 16  
court of the county of the child's residence. 17



Whenever a case is transferred to the county of the  
child's residence and it appears to the court of that county  
that the interests of justice and the convenience of the parties  
requires that the adjudicatory hearing be had in the county in  
which the complaint was filed, the court may return the  
proceeding to the county in which the complaint was filed for  
the purpose of the adjudicatory hearing. The court may  
thereafter proceed as to the transfer to the county of the  
child's legal residence as provided in this section.

Certified copies of all legal and social records  
pertaining to the case shall accompany the transfer.

Any court cost, fine, restitution, or other monetary  
penalty imposed at the time of a transfer made under this  
section is not a final, appealable order."
