## Bill Analysis

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	“Patrolman Sean VanDenberg Memorial Highway” <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of S.R. 236 between S.R. 93, in Summit County, and Lafayette Drive, in Stark County
<b>Other Information</b>	Patrolman VanDenberg served with the Lawrence Township Police Department for eight years. He died from complications as a result of contracting COVID-19 from arresting and transporting a COVID-19 positive suspect to jail after serving a warrant.
