**"Section 9.** By repealing section 3701.89 of the Revised Code, it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Ohio Medical Quality Foundation, a nonprofit corporation organized and formed under Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code, dissolve itself and take such actions as are required by that chapter to wind up its affairs. The General Assembly also directs the 62  
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Foundation to transfer all of its remaining unencumbered funds, 68  
to the extent possible under law and contract, to the monitoring 69  
organization that the State Medical Board contracts with 70  
pursuant to section 4731.25 of the Revised Code. Following the 71  
transfer, the monitoring organization shall use the funds for 72  
purposes of the confidential monitoring program established and 73  
administered under sections 4731.25 to 4731.255 of the Revised 74

**Pharmacist reimbursement for lockable containers** 77

**Section 333.270 of H.B. 33 of the 135th General Assembly** 78

Removes the bill's changes to existing law that requires 79  
the Department of Medicaid to reimburse pharmacists for costs 80  
related to dispensing drugs in lockable containers or tamper- 81  
evident containers. 82

**ICF/IID peer group 5 Medicaid payment rate** 83

**Section 5** 84

Removes a provision that would have required the 85  
Department of Developmental Disabilities to redetermine the per 86  
Medicaid day payment rate for ICFs/IID in peer group 5 that on 87  
July 1, 2023, exceeded the average total per Medicaid day 88  
payment rate for developmental centers that was in effect on 89  
July 1, 2013. 90

payment rate for ICFs/IID in peer group 5 is to be calculated in	94

with the State Medical Board.	144
Requires the monitoring organization to use transferred	145
funds for purposes of administering the confidential monitoring	146

program for impaired practitioners licensed by, or seeking 147  
licensure with, the Medical Board. 148
