"Sec. 3319.238. (A) Except as provided in division (F) of 8
this section, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, a school 9
district shall require an individual to have an educator license 10
validation in financial literacy to provide financial literacy 11
instruction under division (C) (9) of section 3313.603 of the 12
Revised Code. 13

(B) To obtain a license validation in financial literacy, 14
an individual shall hold a valid educator license issued under 15
section 3319.22 or 3319.26 of the Revised Code or a permanent 16
teaching certificate issued under former law and meet additional 17



requirements adopted under rules by the state board of 18
education. 19

(C) Prior to adopting rules under division (B) of this 20
section, the state board shall establish and consult with an 21
advisory committee of at least four classroom teachers and one 22
expert in financial literacy instruction for classroom teachers. 23
The classroom teachers shall include a representative of each of 24
the following: 25

(1) The Ohio council of teachers of mathematics; 26

(2) The Ohio council for the social studies; 27

(3) The Ohio business educators association; 28

(4) The Ohio association of teachers of family and 29
consumer sciences. 30

(D) Each district shall pay for any costs necessary for an 31
individual employed by the district who is required under 32
division (A) of this section to meet the additional requirements 33
adopted by the state board under division (B) of this section. 34
The district may seek reimbursement from the department of 35
education for those costs under section 3319.239 of the Revised 36
Code. 37

(E) This section does not apply to any chartered nonpublic 38
school. 39

(F) A classroom teacher who holds a valid educator license 40
or endorsement that is required to provide instruction in social 41
studies, family and consumer sciences, mathematics, or business 42
education shall not be required to have a validation prescribed 43
under this section to provide financial literacy instruction 44
under division (C) (9) of section 3313.603 of the Revised Code. A 45

teacher to which this division applies may obtain the validation 46
described in division (A) of this section at the district's 47
expense." 48
