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development, marine cargo terminal operations, and travel and 182 tourism on the Ohio River and its tributaries. 183 Specifies the Commission's powers and duties, which 184 include developing a master plan for Ohio River infrastructure 185 and transportation projects. 186 Requires every other Ohio authority, commission, 187 department, or agency to provide the Commission with data, 188 plans, research, and any other information that the Commission 189 requests to assist it in performing its duties. 190 Allows the Commission to issue grants and loans for the 191 development of the Ohio River infrastructure or for continuing 192 or instituting Ohio River transportation in Ohio. 193 Creates the Ohio River Commission of Ohio Fund to be used 194 for the Commission's purposes and to pay its administrative 195 expenses. 196

Requires the Controlling Board to approve any expenditures197by the Department of Development, the Commission, or any other198state agency for capital improvements to promote economic199development, marine cargo terminal operations, and travel and200tourism on the Ohio River and its tributaries.201

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
