- (E) There is hereby appropriated from money in the state treasury amounts necessary to fully pay debt service and financing costs, and lease rental payments pursuant to lease agreements, for fiscal years 2024 and 2025 on bonds and notes, or other obligations of the state issued under the Ohio Constitution and acts of the General Assembly.
