Let me tell you about Wright-Patt Air Force Base. One of the largest and most complex bases in the US Air Force with a long history of flight tests from the Wright Brothers on Huffman Prairie into the space age. Wright-Patt is the headquarters for the Air Force Material Command, a major Air Force Medical Center and the Air Force Institute of Technology. Not to mention the Air Force Research Laboratory, 88<sup>th</sup> Air Base Wing, 655th Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance Wing. Ohio is also home to the National Air and Space Intelligence Center, the 178<sup>th</sup> Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Group in Springfield, and the NASA Glenn Research Center in Cleveland.

Ohio is where flight began; Ohio leads in innovations in flight, technology and space research, we already have the infrastructure and the assets to support Space Command Headquarters.
