

## **Committee Minutes**

Chairman Holmes then called forward House Bill 477 for its second hearing. Seeing that there was no one wishing to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the bill, that concluded its second hearing.

Sean Calhoun and Hilliard Deputy Chief Ron Clark were then called forward by Chairman Holmes to provide their Drone Capabilities with Law Enforcement overview. Committee members asked questions and the gentlemen provided answers.

After seeing no further business, the committee adjourned at 11:17am.
