Please oppose HB58, currently in the Senate Government Oversight Committee. House Bill 58 was recently amended in the Senate to no longer require becoming a licensed Esthetician to do Lash Extensions. The massive reduction in training for these professions will pose a risk to the public we serve, devalue our current licenses, and reduce the career opportunities and earning potential for new licensees looking to enter the field. As a member of the beauty and barber industry, we ask that you protect our profession from this legislation which is intended to flood the market with minimally trained licensees to benefit a few powerful interests that do not represent the vast majority of voices in our profession.
