

Opponent Testimony - written House Joint Resolution 1 Jona Hilario OPAWL Co-Director Ohio House Constitutional Resolutions Committee April 15, 2023

Chairman Plummer and members of the House Constitutional Resolutions Committee,

Thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony. My name is Jona Hilario, I am a resident of Columbus, Ohio and current Statewide Co-Director of OPAWL. We are a statewide grassroots community of Asian and Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI)Women and non-binary people in Ohio. Our organization is a multi-ethnic, multi-generational community and we represent the diverse diaspora from Asia and the Pacific Islands.

OPAWL urges this committee to commit to fairness and democracy and reject House Joint Resolution 1.

I was naturalized as a citizen of this country just this past November after residing here for almost 18 years and being a permanent resident for 14 years. During that time I set down roots in Columbus, had a family, bought a house and started an organization that among other things worked to engage the AAPI community in the democratic process. During the 2020 elections we had 10000 conversations with AAPI voters in Ohio to ensure that they knew how to vote safely while the pandemic was raging. As someone who then did not have the right to vote I worked many many hours convincing those who did that elections matter, that lifting up their voices through the ballot box will ensure that their interests and needs can be addressed.
