LaRe moved for HB 385 to be favorably reported and recommended for passage. With 11 affirmative votes and 0 negative votes, the bill passed. This concluded the fourth hearing of HB 385.

Chair Abrams then called up HB 328 for its fourth hearing. Chair Abrams recognized Rep. Plummer for a motion. Rep. Plummer moved to amend with AM 2135. Without objection, the amendment was adopted by the committee. Chair Abrams then recognized Rep. Plummer for another motion. Rep. Plummer moved to amend with AM 1734-1. Without objection, the amendment was adopted by the committee. This concluded the fourth hearing of HB 328.

Chair Abrams then called up HB 289 for its fifth hearing. With no one present to provide testimony, Chair Abrams directed members to their Ipads for written testimony. This concluded the fifth hearing of HB 289.

Chair Abrams then called up HB 295 for its fourth hearing. With no one present to provide testimony, Chair Abrams directed members to their Ipads for written testimony. This concluded the fourth hearing of HB 295.
