The mining of uranium, the main fuel for generation of nuclear power, results in considerable environmental damage and involves the transportation of dangerous radioactive materials over long distances. Finally, nuclear power is expensive. We all now about the efforts of First Energy to bail out their expensive, money-losing nuclear plants by increasing electricity rates. Real green energy, i.e. solar and wind, have become much less costly and result in minimal pollution and no greenhouse gases. The choice is clear: Ohio needs to develop more solar and wind power and avoid the pitfalls of nuclear power. Please oppose HB 308.
