State funds (R.C. 9.042)	
Prohibits states funds from being given directly or indirectly to any entity that supports, promotes, or provides abortions.	Prohibits states funds from being given directly or indirectly to any entity that provides elective abortion, i.e., an abortion not necessary to protect the life of the mother, or elective abortion services, including but not limited to transportation, housing, wage reimbursement, or paid time off directly related to providing for an elective abortion.
County and municipal funds (R.C. 305.44 and 701.11)	
Requires counties and municipal corporations to report abortion-related spending to the state and reduces local government fund distributions to those counties and municipal corporations by the amount reported.	Same, but limited to spending on elective abortions.
