

Mr. Chairman, Ranking Member, Members of the Committee,

I am an American. I love my Country. I love my freedom; and I love my Constitution! We love our Constitution! In so many ways it is neglected, disregarded, and disobeyed by our current government; but even as badly as it is ignored, it is still a bulwark to protect our liberties from government tyranny!
