Thank you for allowing me to provide support testimony for HB 319; “The Conscientious Right to Refuse Act.”

I am writing this letter to you and your committee as a proponent of free choice being given when any person has either religious or potential health issues with regard to medical treatment or medical experiments, including virus injections.

The Nuremberg Code, written by two US lawyers after the Nuremberg trials, stated two conditions regarding participation in any experimental drug trials:

- 1) No person can be forced to participate in a drug experiment if it is being done against their will.
- 2) No person can be subjected to any penalties for refusing to participate in the experiment.

HB 319; “The Conscientious Right to Refuse Act” is of critical importance. I have acquaintances in the medical field that were forced to retire or change jobs because they refused the vaccine injections. I met an RN from Springfield, OH that was forced to be vaccinated because she worked in a senior citizen center. She was told if she didn’t take the shots, she would be fired. She took one shot. Within a few hours, she could not walk or talk. She never had the opportunity to take a second shot, and she has remained disabled.

I am asking you and your committee members to pass HB 319; “The Conscientious Right to Refuse Act.” The experiences from the extended pandemic have shown that there was inadequate analysis of who should and who should not be vaccinated. Employers and government agencies promoted vaccines without full regard for the consequences of the COVID-19 vaccines, and this cannot be allowed to be repeated.
