

Dear Chairman Lampton, Vice Chair Barhorst, Ranking Member Miranda, and members of the Ohio House Insurance Committee—

On behalf of the Fellows of the American College of Surgeons, Ohio Chapter, I am writing today to express our support for House Bill 24, sponsored by State Representative Andrea White. Through the ACS Commission on Cancer, our Fellows are dedicated to improving the survival and quality of life for cancer patients. Passage of HB 24 would aid us in this important effort, and we commend the bill sponsor and cosponsors for bringing this measure forward.

As you know, HB 24 would require health plans and Ohio Medicaid to cover biomarker testing for the diagnosis, treatment, and management of a disease. Biomarker testing is becoming increasingly utilized for cancer patients and other applications are being researched. For surgeons working with cancer patients, biomarker testing is a valuable tool. For example, a recent study published in the *Journal of the American College of Surgeons* found that microRNA's can be used as a biomarker to predict breast cancer resurgence and mortality.<sup>i</sup>

Four states have already passed biomarker testing legislation with several more joining Ohio in considering this important issue. Incorporating biomarker testing into a cancer patient's course of treatment has been shown to improve outcomes and lower costs. This bill has the potential to be lifesaving for many Ohioans and we urge your support. Thank you for your time and consideration.
