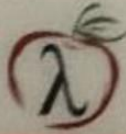
In October 2022 a 13 year old student at Memorial Middle School was having severe anxiety and depression for several weeks. She repeatedly had to leave class to go into the hall way and cry. This took place over several weeks and not one teacher or other school employee notified the parents until October 28. The child's friend noticed she was suicidal and took her to the counselor. This counselor administered the suicide survey in front of the friend and then called her parents. This child was robbed of help and her parents robbed of the opportunity to love her unconditionally all because activist teachers decided they knew what was best for this child and every child who is LGBTQ.

The Hilliard Teachers Union brought in badges for teachers to wear that say "Safe person Safe space" on the front and a qr code on the back that leads to pornographic websites. This is a program created by the NEA. The qr code links to a website that gives step by step instructions on how to perform specific sexual acts such as rimming, muffing, bdsm and more. There was also a video entitled Sex Acts That Don't Get Enough Play. In this video a group of teens are wearing signs on their shirts with names of sex acts and one girl has a sex toy in each hand and high fiving boys with them. Now most of the inappropriate links have been pulled down but they were there previously and screen shots are below.

We also have an issue with school library books containing adult sexual content. For example, *This Book Is Gay* is a literal instruction manual on how to perform sex acts including inserting instruments into the rectum which could lead to perforation and taking the street version of nitroglycerin pills to enhance orgasm. The book, *Call Me By My Name*, depicts a teen boy masturbating with a peach then ejaculating in it and his adult male lover proceeds to eat the peach then kiss the boy.

There are stories like this from all over the state. Activist teachers supported by the Teacher's Union are sexualizing our kids. We need school choice so parents can protect their children and execute their parental rights to place their children in schools that are focused on academics and not pushing an ideology.

I implore you to vote for the Back Pack bill and show parents that you stand with us.

RIMMING

Stimulating the anus of another person using the tongue and mouth.

Serves: 2 or more

Ingredients:

Tongue
Bum
Dental Dam
A shit ton of consent

Substitutions: Oral sex

Notes: Many people feel this recipe works best when all necessary "pots and pans" have been cleaned thoroughly beforehand. If concerned about cleanliness, you might

consider a shower before rimming

Prep/Cook Time: As long as it takes

Steps:

1. Get consent
2. Dive on down
3. Use your tongue or mouth to stimulate bumhole area
4. Throw in a finger if the receiver is into it
5. Remember to ask for continued consent

MUFFING

Using fingers or other objects to stimulate a trans woman or MAAB (male-assigned-at-birth) person internally through the inguinal canals.

Serves: 1 or more

Ingredients:

Lube
Fingers
Inguinal canals
A shit ton of consent

Substitutions:

Anal sex, fingering, masturbation

Notes: Inguinal canals are located in any body. They're diagonally oriented tubes running in the groin area round the middle of the pelvis (You can't see them). Often used when "tucking" among trans women

Prep/Cook Time: As long as it takes. Take your time.

Steps:

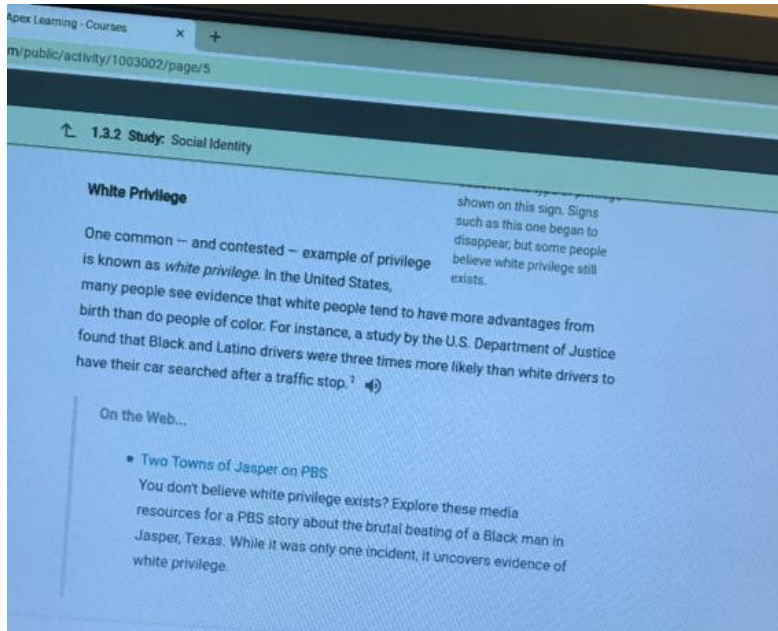
1. Get consent
2. Find the inguinal canals. They're located behind the scrotum and are angled diagonally outwards
3. Use lube
4. Start slowly, maybe with a pinky finger: the canals can be tight

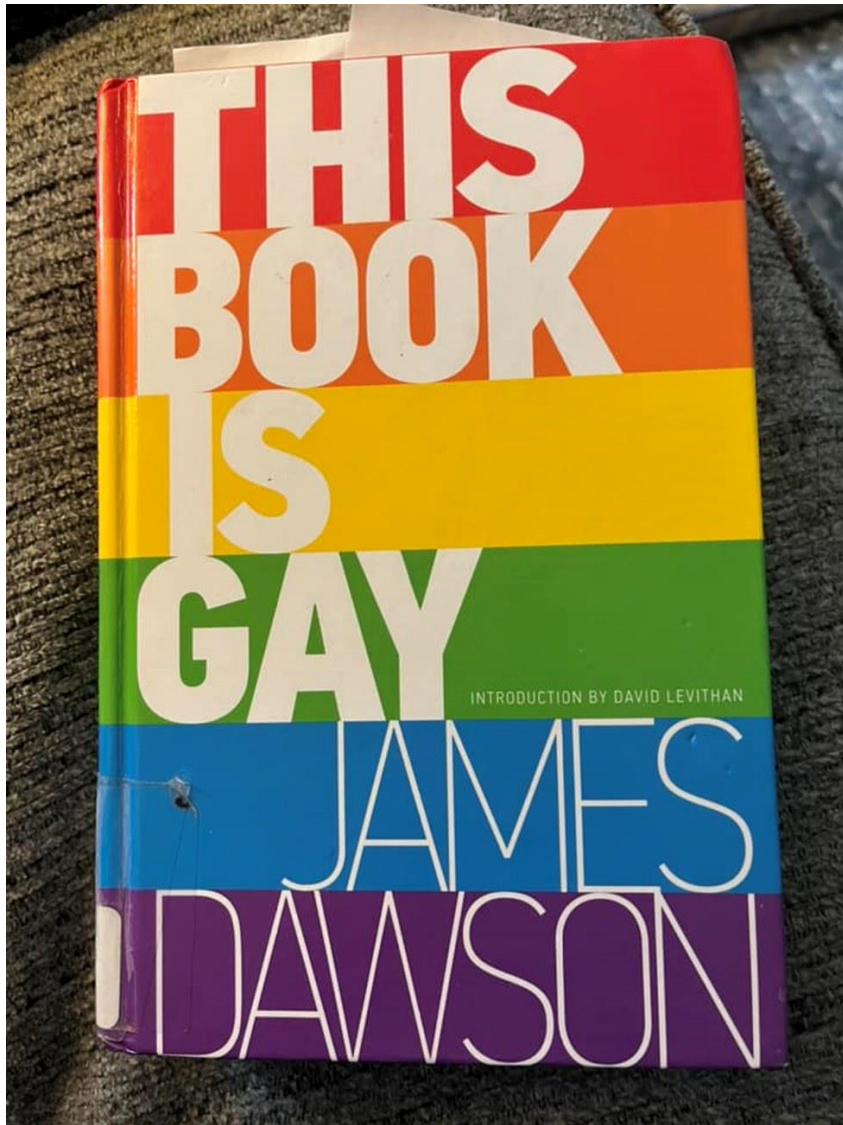

<h2>ANAL SEX</h2> <p>Using toys or parts of a body in and around a person's bum.</p> <p>Serves: 2 or more</p> <p>Ingredients: Condoms or gloves Bum Lube Fingers/Sex Toy/Penis A shit ton of consent</p> <p>Substitutions: Fingering or other penetration</p> <p>Notes: Go slow, it might take awhile to get comfortable</p> <p>Prep/Cook Time: As long as it takes. May take longer than expected. Some days are not good for anal sex days.</p> <p>Steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Get consent from all parties 2. Make sure that the person being penetrated is relaxed 3. Use a lot of lube! 4. Start slow, inserting one finger first and gradually building up to more fingers or penis or sex toy 5. Remember to ask for continued consent 	<h2>BONDAGE</h2> <p>Restraining a person's body to restrict their movements for physical and psychological pleasure.</p> <p>Serves: 2 or more</p> <p>Ingredients: Rope/ribbon/scarves/tape/belts/chains... A safe word and clear boundaries A shit ton of consent</p> <p>Substitutions: Roleplay</p> <p>Notes: One example of how safe words can be used is "red, yellow, green", with "red" meaning stop, "yellow" meaning slow down, and "green" meaning keep going</p> <p>Prep/Cook Time: As long as it takes. Could be shorter than expected.</p> <p>Steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Get Consent 2. Start simple, with soft materials and knots that can be easily undone 3. Make sure that the ties don't cut off blood to any part of the body

HIV: A virus affecting the immune system.

Intersectionality: The different parts of your whole identity and the impact they have on your life.

Intersex: Term to describe a person born with no clear gender or attributes of both genders.

Labia: The folds at the entrance of the vagina.

Lesbian: A homosexual woman.

Lube: Short for lubricant. Makes sex easier.

Orgasm: Sexual climax.

Part Two: Girl-on-Girl Sex

Here is a diagram of a woman. If you are also a woman, you are probably aware which parts FEEL NICE when you touch them, but here's a rough guide.
