and I am from Morrow County, Ohio.

I am writing to strongly urge you to pass HB 445 in support of Released Time Religious Instruction for Ohio's public school children. I believe the only right choice is to give parents and guardians who so choose the right to send their children to Released Time Religious Instruction programs in ALL Ohio school districts and municipalities. The 1952 Supreme Court ruling Zorach v. Clauson already allows for such programs. HB 445 will allow parents the right and guardians the right to make decisions for their own children instead of the school.
