I speak in support of giving parents the ultimate decision about their students taking advantage of release-time opportunities, and urge you to make a small but significant change in HB 445 by requiring school districts to allow religious release time when parents request it.

I have watched the phenomenal group of the Lifewise Academy in my county, in which groups of interested parents from across the district and church community draw together to provide moral and character lessons using stories from the Bible, something that was an integral part of American public education for most of the first 200 years of the country's existence.
