## Opponent Testimony for H.B. 445 Primary and Secondary Education Committee November 11, 2024

Thank you for allowing me to submit this testimony. My name is Barbara Norris and I reside in Wayne County. I am a retired parent of 2 children who attended Wooster public schools. Not once did I feel a need for them to be provided with released time religious instruction during the school day. Opportunities for religious instruction abound in my community and I see no reason why it needs to be mandated that schools allow for release time during the school day.

I write this in opposition to House Bill 445. I believe in the autonomy of local school boards and this bill undermines this. I also strongly believe that public schools need to maintain neutrality towards religion and this bill will threaten a core principle of our constitution.

This bill makes unnecessary changes to a program that is already in place.
