

Proponent Testimony by Rachel Cannon on House Bill 197

A community solar pilot program is straight-forward, smart policy for Ohio. Community solar allows more Ohioans to enjoy the cost-savings of clean solar energy on their bill every month. Community solar has been successful policy across the country. A pilot program ensures Ohio's community solar program will best meet the needs of Ohio residents and businesses. According to Ohio University Voinovich School of Leadership and Public Service, this bill will grow Ohio's economy by \$3.49 billion, bring in \$409.5 million in lifetime local tax revenue, and create over 27 thousand job years!
