Referral Report

February 21, 2023

Representative Russo reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 53 – Representatives Schmidt, Miller, A.

To authorize refundable tax credits for hiring certain veterans, service members, and their spouses.

To the committee on Ways and Means

H. B. No. 54 – Representative Grim

To designate the interchange of I-475 and Dorr Street in Lucas County as the "Keith Earley Memorial Interchange."

To the committee on Transportation

H. B. No. 55 – Representatives John, Lear

To designate a portion of State Route 97 in Richland County as the "Firefighter Charles D. Swank Memorial Highway."

To the committee on Transportation

H. B. No. 56 – Representatives Plummer, White

To increase penalties for fleeing from law enforcement, to require law enforcement entities to have a policy governing the pursuit of a motor vehicle, and to prohibit hooning and being a spectator at a hooning event.

H. B. No. 57 – Representatives Hall, Demetriou

To index the homestead exemption amounts to inflation.

To the committee on Ways and Means

H. B. No. 58 – Representative Gross

To enact the Provider of Boutique Services Opportunity Act regarding natural hair stylists and boutique salon registrants and to amend the versions of sections 4713.10, 4713.30, and 4713.31 and to repeal the version of section 4713.69 of the Revised Code that are scheduled to take effect on December 29, 2023, to continue the changes on and after that date.
