Representative Russo reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 121 – Representatives Robb Blasdel, Mathews

To allow businesses with remote workers to use a modified municipal income tax apportionment formula.

To expand intimidation offenses to include guardians ad litem and court-appointed special advocates.
