### **Referral Report**

May 2, 2023

Representative Russo reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills and Senate Bills, to be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 156 – Representatives Manning, Oelslager**

To amend the law related to physician-administered drugs.

**To the committee on Insurance**

**H. B. No. 157 – Representatives Weinstein, Somani**

To create the Bureau of Hate Crimes in the Office of the Attorney General and to authorize the Attorney General to prosecute hate crimes.

**To the committee on State and Local Government**

**H. B. No. 158 – Representatives Roemer, Miller, M.**

To make changes to the law governing the regulation of cosmetologists and barbers.

**To the committee on Commerce and Labor**

**H. B. No. 159 – Representative Lipps**

To require data collection, reporting, and outreach regarding applied behavior analysis for children with autism who are Medicaid enrollees.

**To the committee on Behavioral Health**

**H. B. No. 160 – Representative Santucci**

Regarding limitations imposed by health insurers on dental care services.

**To the committee on Insurance**

**H. B. No. 161 – Representatives Miranda, Hillyer**

To eliminate the spousal exceptions for the offenses of rape, sexual battery, unlawful sexual conduct with a minor, gross sexual imposition, sexual imposition, and importuning and to permit a person to testify against the person's spouse in a prosecution for any of those offenses.

To make specified day and week designations relating to agriculture.

**H. B. No. 163 – Representative Gross**

To exclude central bank digital currencies from being treated as money under the Ohio Uniform Commercial Code.

**To the committee on Financial Institutions**

**H. B. No. 164 – Representatives Jarrells, Seitz**

To establish the Foster-to-College Scholarship Program, to require the Department of Education to hire a full-time school foster care liaison, and to make an appropriation for the Foster-to-College Scholarship Program.

**S. B. No. 16 – Senator Wilson**

To alter the law governing immunity from liability for donations of perishable food.

**To the committee on Civil Justice**

**Sub. S. B. No. 49 – Senator Reynolds**

To enact the Religious Expression Days "R.E.D." Act to require each kindergarten through 12 public school to adopt a policy providing students with religious accommodations.

**To the committee on Primary and Secondary Education**

**S. B. No. 58 – Senators Johnson, Gavarone**

To prohibit requiring fees or firearms liability insurance for the possession of firearms, or fees for the possession of knives.
