Rules Report

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, May 23, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, May 24, 2023

Sub. H. B. No. 27 Mathews, Thomas, J., et al. – To require state institutions of higher education to provide financial cost and aid disclosure forms.

H. B. No. 57 Hall, Demetriou, et al. – To index the homestead exemption amounts to inflation.

Am. H. B. No. 50 Humphrey, Seitz, et al. – To create a mechanism by which an individual who is subject to a collateral sanction for housing may obtain a certificate of qualification for housing that may provide relief from certain bars on housing.

H. B. No. 47 Brown, Bird, et al. – To require the placement of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) in each public and chartered nonpublic school and each public recreational facility and to require the Ohio Department of Health to develop a model emergency action plan for the use of AEDs.

Am. H. B. No. 105 Thomas, J., et al. – To modify the law regarding extensions for filing municipal income tax returns and to limit penalties for late filings.

H. B. No. 61 Troy, Callender, et al. – To designate November 19th as "James A. Garfield Day."

H. B. No. 66 Hall, Stoltzfus, et al. – Regarding the deduction and recovery of bad debts for cigarette and tobacco and vapor products taxes.

H. C. R. No. 5 Miller, J., Holmes, et al. – To support and encourage the work of the Ohio Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial in celebrating the nation's 250th anniversary.

H. B. No. 28 Humphrey, et al. – To designate March as "Triple Negative Breast Cancer Awareness Month."
