Representative Russo reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 339 – Representative Click

To establish the Nonchartered Educational Savings Account Program.

To the committee on Primary and Secondary Education

H. B. No. 340 – Representatives Peterson, Dobos

To authorize an employee mobility grant program to be administered by the Director of Development and to make an appropriation.

To the committee on Economic and Workforce Development

H. B. No. 341 – Representative Click

To revise the law regarding adult use marijuana.

To enact the Reproductive Care Act regarding abortion, abortion-related laws, and reproductive health protections; to amend the version of section 3702.30 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect September 30, 2024; and to repeal the version of section 5103.11 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect January 1, 2025, to continue the changes on and after those dates.
