The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, December 5, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, December 6, 2023

H. B. No. 165 Lear, Ferguson, et al. – To designate a portion of State Route 36 in Delaware County as the "Representative Kris Jordan Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 26 Wiggam, et al. – To designate a portion of State Route 301 in Wayne County as the "Town and Country Firefighter Lt. Philip M. Wigal Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 253 Upchurch, Holmes, et al. – To designate portions of United States Routes 42, 68, and 62 as the "Brigadier General Charles Young Memorial Historical Corridor."

H. B. No. 202 Thomas, J., et al. – To designate a portion of United States Route 62 in Canton as the "Specialist Dennis Alan Combs Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 190 Brent, White, et al. – To designate the week of April 11 to April 17 as "Black Maternal Health Week."

H. C. R. No. 7 Creech, Peterson, et al. – To urge Congress to make daylight saving time the permanent standard time.

H. B. No. 195 Demetriou, Brennan, et al. – To create an adaptive mobility dealer license.

Am. H. B. No. 78 Seitz, Miller, J., et al. – Regarding State Teachers Retirement System Board member eligibility and system membership for student teachers who are employed as substitute teachers.

Sub. H. C. R. No. 6 King, Plummer, et al. – To urge Congress to repeal the Windfall Elimination Provision and the Government Pension Offset.

H. B. No. 173 Troy, et al. – To designate the month of May as "Older Ohioans Month."

Am. H. B. No. 203 Roemer, Sweeney, et al. – To require owners of private construction projects to timely pay contractors.

Am. H. B. No. 29 Humphrey, Brewer, et al. – To make changes to the law governing driver's license suspensions for failure to pay child support.

Am. H. B. No. 272 Mathews, Pizzulli – To allow a concealed handgun licensee to carry a handgun in a building or structure that is not a courthouse but in which a courtroom is located in specified circumstances and to permit a nonresident of Ohio to obtain statutory relief from firearms disability based on an Ohio conviction, guilty plea, or delinquent child adjudication.

Sub. H. B. No. 51 Loychik, Schmidt – To enact the Second Amendment Preservation Act to add additional protections to the right to bear arms and to declare an emergency.
