**H. B. No. 269 Holmes, et al.** – To designate a portion of State Route 60 in Muskingum County as the "Sgt Bradley J. Harper USMC Memorial Highway."

**Am. H. B. No. 293 Hoops, et al.** – To designate a portion of State Route 109 in Henry County as the "Marjorie Whiteman Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 128 Cutrona, et al.** – To designate a portion of State Route 46 in Mahoning County as the "Officer T.J. D'Apolito Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 268 Schmidt, et al.** – To designate a portion of State Route 32 in Clermont County as the "Richard "Dick" Mallon Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 147 Fowler Arthur, Miller, A., et al.** – Regarding teacher licensure revocation, teacher hiring practices, and conduct unbecoming to the teaching profession.

**Am. H. B. No. 111 LaRe, Miller, K., et al.** – To increase the sentencing range for third degree felony domestic violence and to create a presumption in favor of a prison term for the offense.

# Ohio House of Representatives



**Sub. H. B. No. 56 Plummer, White, et al.** – To require law enforcement entities to train officers related to the pursuit of a motor vehicle and to increase penalties for fleeing from law enforcement and forms of stunt driving.

**Am. H. B. No. 241 Miller, J., Miller, K., et al.** – Regarding training schools for prospective law enforcement officers and filling a vacant police department position without a competitive examination.

**H. B. No. 305 Stewart, Brown, et al.** – To provide for the electronic filing of pleadings or documents in courts of common pleas except a probate or juvenile court, in municipal courts, and in county courts, to permit the clerk to disburse funds for the computerization of the clerk's office without the court's authorization, and to permit municipal and county courts to increase the maximum amount of their additional fees from ten dollars to twenty dollars to cover the computerization of the clerk's office.

**H. B. No. 141 LaRe, Robb Blasdel, et al.** – To restrict cost-sharing requirements with regard to occupational and physical therapists and chiropractors.

**Sub. H. B. No. 93 Johnson, McClain, et al.** – Regarding limitations on recovery and lien imposition by municipalities against property owners of non-owner-occupied properties for unpaid water, sewer, and disposal services rates and charges.
