Referral Report

Representative Grim reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills, House Joint Resolution, and Senate Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 628 – Representative Williams

To designate a portion of I-280 in Lucas County as the "SSG Jack W. Coy Memorial Highway." **To the committee on Transportation**

H. B. No. 629 – Representative Edwards

To provide authorization and conditions for the operation of certain state programs, to make capital appropriations and reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2026, to make other appropriations, and to declare an emergency.

H. J. R. No. 7 – Representatives Wiggam, Young, T.

Proposing to enact Section 5 of Article XV of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to adopt the American Allegiance Amendment to prohibit individuals with citizenship in other countries from holding elected public offices.

Sub. S. B. No. 112 - Senator Rulli

To require school buildings to comply with national life safety standards and to name this act the Ohio Childhood Safety Act.


Am. S. B. No. 176 – Senators Sykes, Romanchuk
