Chairman Wiggam, Vice Chair Dean, Ranking Member Brennan, and other members of the House State and Local Committee, I thank you for the opportunity to give sponsor testimony on House Bill 491. This is a simple bill that requires political subdivisions to enter both their expenditure information and their revenues on The Ohio Checkbook site for public review. This is an easy and quick way for counties, cities, villages, etc. to provide more information to the people they serve; increasing the trust that citizens have with the organizations that are serving them.

The Ohio Treasurer is committed to making it as easy as possible to join the Ohio checkbook. The office will be glad to assist public entities, especially our smallest villages and townships. Public records, including those about expenditures and revenues, are one way that citizens can be actively engaged in their local government entities by giving their Checkbook a check-up.

On behalf of the constituents of the 91st House District of Ohio, I strongly support this bill and encourage you to think about your own constituents and if you believe they would benefit in any
