Chairman Wiggam called the meeting of the House State and Local Government Committee to order at 3:32 p.m.

Roll was called, a quorum was present, and the minutes were approved.

Chairman Wiggam called HB 315 for its fifth hearing. Representative Hall moved to amend with AM_135_1838 and explained the amendment. There was no discussion, and the amendment was approved without objection. Representative Troy moved to amend with AM_135_1953 and explained the amendment. There was discussion and an objection was made. The roll was called amendment was approved by a vote of 12-1. Vice Chairman Dean moved to amend with AM_135_2165 and explained the amendment. Representative Hall moved to table the amendment. There was discussion, the roll was called, and the amendment was tabled by a vote of 9-4. Representative Hall moved to favorably report HB 315. There was discussion, the roll was called, and the bill was favorably reported unanimously. The Chairman directed LSC to harmonize the amendments into a substitute bill.

Chairman Wiggam called HB 353 for its first hearing. Representatives Brewer and Mohamed provided sponsor testimony and answered questions from the committee.

Chairman Wiggam called HB 373 for its third hearing. The committee heard no testimony on the bill.

Chairman Wiggam called HB 497 for its second hearing. Representative King moved to amend with AM_135_2120 and explained the amendment. There was no discussion, and the amendment was approved without objection. Chris Abbuhl, Tuscarawas County Commissioner, provided proponent testimony on the bill, and answered questions from the committee. Chairman Wiggam directed committee members' attention to written testimony on the iPads.
