- Holding mobile office hours for consumers in underserved communities in our service area such as Batavia, Hamilton, Mt Orab, Georgetown, and West Union
- Expand Youth Transition services that promote life skills needed to live as independently as possible in adulthood
- Hire an additional staff person to respond the dozens of calls per week we receive from people looking for both accessible, and affordable housing for people with disabilities

This funding will be vital to the services we offer in our region, and we appreciate your support.
