

Testimony on SFY 24/25 Operating Budget House Finance Health and Human Services Sub-Committee

Chairwoman Carruthers, Ranking Member Liston, and esteemed committee members, I want to thank you for the opportunity to testify before you today.

My name is Amy Tims and I am the (Community Engagement Specialist) of RT Industries, and we are located in Troy Ohio, serving Miami, Shelby, Darke, Auglaize & Montgomery Counties. We are an organization that provides day, and employment services through the home and community-based waiver program administered by the Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD). Our team of thirty (30) Direct Support Professionals are proud to provide essential services to over one hundred fifty (150) Ohioans with intellectual and developmental disabilities each month.

I am very supportive of the budget initiatives outlined by Governor DeWine and Director Hauck for DODD. The changing labor landscape and accompanying shortage of workers, including direct support professionals (DSP), threatens our ability to provide the critical supports on which our the people we serve and their families rely.

To be able to hire and retain staff here at RR Industries, the reimbursement rates need to increased. This will not only benefit RT Industries, but more importantly, the persons we serve. RT is important to the persons served because we offer a place for them to come and participate in activities, go out and be a part of the community and make friends. This also gives their families time during the day to meet their own needs and complete any tasks they have. In closing, we are an important part of their lives of the people served and their families and the increase to the reimbursement rates is crucial.

The Governor's proposed budget initiatives, guided by the leadership of Director Hauck, is a great foundation to reinforce and rebuild the services provided by RT Industries. We **encourage this subcommittee to approve the Governor's budget proposal for DODD and to invest additional dollars into these vital services to raise direct support professional wages to at least an average of \$20.64**. This investment will help us recruit and retain the workforce needed to continue to provide our **quality services**.
