We have to care for our son while we are trying to work and go to school

Dad has to help while mom is working. Mom has to take care of son alone after working all day

Dad has to go back to school to become a nurse since we don't have any help but he cannot get any financial assistance to take the courses and now Dad has to quit nursing school so he can care for his son while mom works and we have zero nurses

Killian left to work at the prison for better pay Sheri left to work at the jail for better pay and better benefits Colleen left to work at the school for better benefits Kay left to work at a nursing home for better pay
