Chair McClain, Vice Chair Dobos, and Ranking Member Grim, and Members of the House Transportation Committee. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on House Bill 251. This bill will designate a portion of state route 88 in Portage County after Ravena Police Officer James R Wert.

Officer James Wert was appointed to the Ravenna Police Department on February 1st 1980 after serving in the U.S. Army where he earned the Army Good Conduct Medal and was an expert marksmen at Ft Hood.

After James was honorably discharged from the Army he chose to move back to Ravena and become a police officer to be close with is family and serve the area where he grew up.

Around Midnight on January 31st in 1981 patrolman Wert stopped a suspected drunk driver. After proceeding with the arrest James proceeded to State Route 88, he pulled off to adjust the arrested party's handcuffs.

A struggle ensued and additional Ravenna police officers arrived to assist Wert. At the time a second drunk driver went left of center of rt 88 and stuck James Wert. Officer Wert was only 25 when he was killed in the line of duty.
