Chair Brenner, Vice Chair O'Brien, Ranking Member Ingram, and members of the Senate Education Committee.

Thank you for allowing me to testify today. My name is Wenda Sheard. I am a taxpaper, and I have been an Ohio attorney for 45 years. I am strongly opposed to House Bill 8.

HB8 is unconstitutionally vague, and against ethical obligations common in many professions.

HB8, if passed, is bound to cost taxpayers a lot of money in attorney fees and litigation expenses. Additionally, HB8, if passed, will be yet another unfunded mandate that will fall upon local schools and their taxpapers to pay.

I ask you to save taxpapers' money. I ask you to save the General Assembly from the embarassment of yet another law declared unconstitutionally. I ask you to vote NO on HB8.
