

Sandra C. Hull

A thirty-two year Executive Director of Main Street Wooster, Inc., a downtown revitalization organization focused on the Main Street Four-Point Approach which is a community-driven, comprehensive strategy that encourages economic development through historic preservation in ways that are appropriate for the 21st century marketplace. Main Street Wooster, Inc. follows the Main Street, four-point approach, a subsidiary of the National Trust of Historic Preservation. Four basic tenets include organization, promotion, design and economic vitality.

200 retail/service related businesses and 100 professional and governmental offices currently exist in the downtown area. The population of Wooster is 27,000, with 110,000 in the county.

To date, more than \$200 million of public/private downtown reinvestment has occurred which includes more than \$90 million of infrastructure improvements. Since 1987, 185 interior/exterior building renovations, 180 net new businesses and 80 expansions of existing businesses, and 352 new, full and part-time jobs created.

Main Street Wooster, Inc. received the Great American Main Street Award in 1996, a Merit Award from the Ohio Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects, Award of Achievement from Northern Ohio Live, and the Economic Development Award for East Ohio Gas and Cleveland Magazine in 1995. The community received the initial Ohio Best Hometown Award from Ohio Magazine and 37th of 100 "Best Hometowns" from Money Magazine in 2017.

Sandra serves as charter trustee for Heritage Ohio, Inc., a statewide program to promote the Main Street process and historic preservation, an Ohio Advisor Emeritus for the National Trust for Historic Preservation, the Ohio Historic Site Preservation Advisory Board (OHSPAB), Advisory Board for First Ladies Library, board member of Wooster Area Chamber of Commerce, Architectural Design & Review Board, City of Wooster, Wooster Rotary member, Board of Learn 'N Play Child Care Center and Advisory Board of Wayne Economic Development Council.

Sandra is a graduate of Northwestern University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Speech Pathology.

She and her husband, Gary, have two children and five grandchildren.
