Sponsor Testimony
Senate Bill 92
General Government Committee
March 28th, 2023

Chairman Rulli, Vice-Chair Schuring, Ranking Member DeMora, thank you for allowing us to provide sponsor testimony on Senate Bill 92, which would allow for August special elections for specific purposes.

At the current moment, the door is cracked open so we are able to hold special elections in August for local fiscal emergencies and congressional seats, as well as major statewide issues. What this legislation does is it broadens that language and opens the door slightly more to include General Assembly initiated constitutional amendments, which require a 3/5 vote in the Senate and 3/5 vote in the House to even go on the ballot.

While questions have been raised in regards to the passage of House Bill 458 last year concerning August special elections, this legislation does not come into conflict with the previous bill from last year. Special elections in August still exist and permitted to take place under certain circumstances. Senate Bill 92 is just adding to what can be allowed on the ballot in August. We are not reinventing the wheel with this legislation.
