My name is Vanessa Joy. I am the Executive Producer and lead host of the Transcending Humanity podcast, as well as a potential candidate for the Ohio House of Representatives in District 50. Additionally, I am a 42 year old out Transgender Woman.

I urge a NO vote on HB 68. The transgender community has become the focal point of the Republican party over the past few years. We are a very small portion of the human population, making up only around 1%. We have always existed and always will exist.

Being transgender is not a choice. We are born this way, no different than people being born with blue or brown eyes. It is part of the genetic shuffle.
