Chairman Huffman, Vice Chair Johnson, and Members of the Senate Health Committee, thank you for hearing my support testimony for HB 73, The Dave & Angie Patient and Health Provider Protection Act.

As a retired physician in the State of Ohio, I recognize the absolute necessity of maintaining the autonomy of the doctor-patient relationship; it is sacred!

Indeed, not only does the W.H.O. have no jurisdiction, but *the State* should not interfere with that private, sacred relationship! Doctors must retain the right to prescribe drugs *off-label*, and to share professional opinions that deviate from mainstream consensus—this is how clinical knowledge & experience grows. Patients have the right to give *informed consent*.

Patients should have access to drugs & therapies recommended by their physicians both inpatient and outpatient.
