## WRITTEN TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF HB 73


#### Abstract

I have been a Nurse Practitioner in Primary Care for 23 years. The health provider/patient relationship is based on honesty and giving factual information so patients can make the best decision for their health in their situation. A patient cannot exercise fully informed consent if healthcare providers are unable to express their concerns about vaccine risks or any health related treatment risks, because at the current time, they face the risk of retaliation against their professional licenses or reputations. The current litigation and revoking or suspending medical professional licenses also deters people from coming into the medical fields.
