

My Testimony

Chairman Huffman, Vice Chair Johnson, and Members of the Senate Health Committee, thank you for hearing my support testimony for HB 73, The Dave & Angie Patient and Health Provider Protection Act

I always considered myself pretty immune to things, hardly ever getting sick. I remember when COVID was happening I kinda felt that this was just a normal flu. It actually took until after Thanksgiving for me to contract it. I noticed because I wasn't feeling well, and I noticed I lost my sense of smell. It was then things turned for the worse.

I contracted it really bad, and in fact, my breathing started to falter. I actually was having a very hard time breathing, so much so that I was taking Tylenol PM to make me sleep through the laborious breathing. I felt like I was suffocating. This went on for two weeks, I couldn't work or do anything, and my breathing got so bad I thought I had to go to the ER to get intubated. I was scared of that happening cause I heard of the high percentage of negative outcomes associated not only with the hospital use of ventilators, but also other medications and vaccines that were not preventing the infection or the spread.

I decided to reach out to a doctor in Florida because Ohio doctors were getting hounded by medical boards and government officials for prescribing Ivermectin. I ordered it through the mail, and symptoms almost entirely disappeared after 2 days. I contracted COVID once more, and using IVERMECTIN again cleared up symptoms instantaneously.

My brother is a pharmacist, and I believe he was also hampered from administering or accessing a generic and demonstrated medication such as IVERMECTIN.

Nobody should be prevented from accessing medicine that has been known to help with these types of viruses for decades because of pharmaceutical corporations profits that get kicked back to elected officials which is treasonous and corrupt.
