**RE: SUPPORT for SB 175, insurance regulations and taxes**

Chair Hackett, Ranking Member Craig, & Members of the Senate Insurance Committee,

Representing nearly 60 percent of the U.S. property casualty insurance market, the American Property Casualty Insurance Association (APCIA) promotes and protects the viability of private competition for the benefit of consumers and insurers. APCIA represents the broadest cross-section of home, auto, and business insurers of any national trade association. In Ohio, APCIA's members write more than \$13.5 billion in property and casualty insurance premiums. We respectfully submit the following comments in **support of SB 175**.

SB 175 contains numerous provisions and amendments to statute, each consistent in reflecting universally agreed upon best practices that are beneficial for businesses, consumers, and insurers alike.
