These clients have medications they need to take daily and at night. If I'm out the client doesn't get their meds. If I'm out they may not have clean clothes or may not have anything to eat until I'm back. Neither one can cook for themselves or even use a microwave. It is extremely important that we do what's right because we're dealing with human beings who have the ability to love and feel emotions like anyone else.
