I could not find a day care provider for my child. so, I had to apply for "Shared Living". When I passed all the requirements, I had to quit my full-time job with benefits so I could take care of my daughter. I lost my insurance, Children that I have custody of got Medicaid. But I made too much money for Medicaid therefore, I have to pay for my medical insurance. I want to buy medical insurance for my family. because Medicaid recipients get pushed back or delayed when they need to have a procedure.
